Record major events, decisions, changes, dependencies, and moments that materially affected the result. **Review record:** Assign the owner, evidence, dependencies, decision date, and next action.

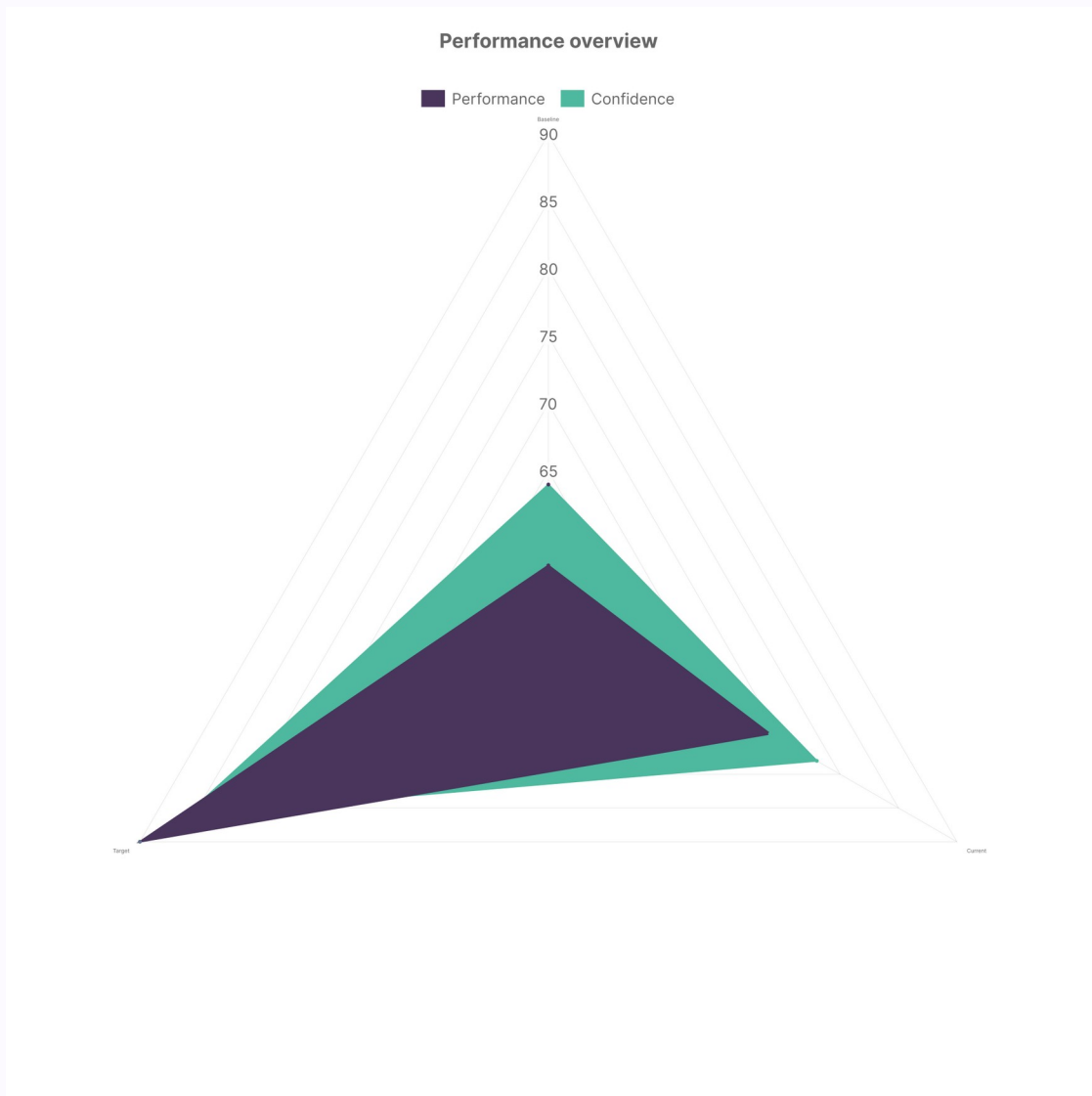


Figure 1: Illustrative performance profile

What worked

Identify repeatable behaviors, practices, controls, tools, and collaboration patterns supported by specific examples.

What was difficult

Describe friction, missed signals, constraints, and consequences without assigning personal blame. **Review record:** Assign the owner, evidence, dependencies, decision date, and next action.

Root-cause themes

Distinguish immediate events from systemic causes across process, information, incentives, capacity, and governance. **Review record:** Assign the owner, evidence, dependencies, decision date, and next action.

Lessons and decisions

State what the organization will preserve, stop, test, standardize, or escalate in future work. **Review record:** Assign the owner, evidence, dependencies, decision date, and next action.

Improvement actions

Assign each improvement an owner, due date, success measure, review forum, and link to the affected standard or backlog. **Review record:** Assign the owner, evidence, dependencies, decision date, and next action.
